literacy skills and improved proficiency in English and mathematics amongst rural schoolchildren in the Jinotega Department.

And our biggest project to-date (by far!) is also now underway -- the development of the Vera Corazón School -- a residential school for disadvantaged girls in Matagalpa. Tentatively set to open in February 2019, the school aims to provide an ideal learning environment, in which students will not only benefit from instruction in standard subjects, but supplementary education in English, IT/computers, leadership, & entrepreneurship, and participation in a wide range of extracurricular opportunities.

With a population of 6.2 million people, Nicaragua is the poorest country in Central America and the second poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. It ranks 125th on the Human Development Index (of 188 countries surveyed). In a country where poverty is so rampant, many people struggle to attain financial security and a good standard of living. According to 2009 statistics, while 42.5% of Nicaraguans live at or below the poverty line, a staggering 63.3% of the rural population lives in poverty.

Over the next several months, we look forward to sharing many more updates with you all on this invigorating new chapter in Visions' development, and we invite you to be a part of the journey!





"Voices of Empowerment" is a short documentary film that seeks to bring forth the compelling stories and voices of the youth Visions serves in Sri Lanka, India, and Ethiopia. Highlighting the daily hardships and obstacles faced by Visions-supported youth, this documentary features one student from each country. In Sri Lanka, we learn about persistence through Sivatharsini, a young woman who endured years of civil war and the loss of her sister in the 2004 tsunami. In India, we meet Gokul, a young Dalit teenager with big dreams. And in Ethiopia, we uncover the determination of Mahelet, as she struggles to navigate life as a Deaf young woman.
