We aim to provide disadvantaged young people, teachers, and communities with strong education in english, IT/computers, leadership, life skills, human rights, health, and more. Of our efforts, 60 % is indirectly implemented through local partner organizations on the ground, 30 % is directly implemented by the Visions organization itself, and 10 % is awareness raising and capacity building.
