

### VISIONS ACADEMY -SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF OPENS IN HAWASSA, ETHIOPIA!

Last month, in partnership with Visions Global Empowerment Ethiopia, we opened the doors to the Visions Academy School for the Deaf -- the first school for deaf children in Hawassa (Ethiopia's 5th largest city with a growing deaf population)!!

It's still early days on a brand new campus that we are still very much developing, but we are thrilled to be able to respond to the overwhelming demand and offer classes for Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 to start. We currently have 41 students but expect to see those



numbers grow. Over the next few years, we will add more grades until hopefully capping out at Grade 12.

### URGENT APPEAL FOR EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS IN WAR-RAVAGED TIGRAY

In November 2020, a civil conflict broke out in the northern Ethiopian region of Tigray, which ultimately claimed the lives of hundreds of thousands of people due to wartime violence, widespread famine, and lack of medical care. Local infrastructure was devastated, including schools. While a peace agreement in 2022 brought the conflict to a close, survivors are still experiencing great distress and are struggling to rebuild their lives. The Koraro Primary School, which serves students in Grades 1-8, urgently needs school supplies for their 1,000+ students. The school reopened its doors in May 2023 for the first time in over three years, but teachers and students alike lack essential materials.
