# Projects Update: Summer Interns Selected; Launch of Scholarship Program; After-School Programs Now Running



Visions is very pleased to announce the selection of three summer interns who will be placed in Colombo, Sri Lanka for one month to represent Visions and help develop our programming on the ground, specifically at the Kalagam Visions Learning Centre (KVLC). These three interns who are each receiving a \$500 grant from Visions for this purpose, will work with students and teachers at the KVLC to develop after-school programs focused on leadership and life skills, strengthening academic opportunities related to English and computer education, and develop a long-term program plan between Kalagam and Visions.

In other news, Visions is turning its attention to building our Scholarship Program for youth and teachers in Sri Lanka and India. Visions has previously given scholarships to students across Sri Lanka for various purposes, but we will be ramping up this effort in the months to come to benefit students and teachers with which Visions has worked. Our most recent scholarship recipient, Kalaivani, has received sponsorship from Visions for English courses at the British Council in Colombo, along with support in the form of a lanton assistance in earning an appointment as a Grade 3 teacher at the Hindu Ladies

In much the same way, Visions intends for our Scholarship Program to reflect the varied needs of each individual and to promote the interests of young leaders who have great potential in becoming positive influences in their communities.

Finally, we are happy to announce that A/L and O/L tuition classes at the after-school center in Karadiyanaru are now up and running, with the same classes in Vaharai expected to begin any day now--ultimately benefiting hundreds of youth who experienced disrupted schooling experiences due to decades of war. Our local partners (CACM) are also currently making good progress in distributing bicycles to a few dozen students who need them to get to/from school each day. Visions made a commitment to provide 17 bicycles to students in need in the Eastern Province. We look forward to providing a thorough update on these efforts and the impact these efforts are having in our next enewsletter.

#### **ORANGE COUNTY**

OC Food Festival: Over 200 people joined the Visions Los Angeles/Orange County Chapter for an international food festival event at the Rush Park Auditorium in Rossmoor, CA on March 5th, raising \$4,000 to help support after-school programs and provide bicycles for impoverished, war-displaced, and flood-affected youth in the communities of Karadiyanaru and Vaharai in Eastern Sri Lanka. The first recipient, Ms. Tharini Shanmugarajah, is not only an exceptional dancer and dance teacher with the Kalapeetham Dance Company, she has held a benefit every year since 2005 to support the efforts of a number of organizations, including charity:water, IMHO, Susan G.
