Investing in Youth Education:

Visions Provides Scholarships to 10 Deserving Youth across Sri Lanka & India

Earlier this month Visions fully sponsored the education of 6 highly disadvantaged young adults in deeply impoverished, tsunami-affected dalit villages in Tamil Nadu, India. These students (4 female & 2 male) are pursuing such courses as Engineering, Agriculture, Teacher Training, Math, & Chemistry. Visions also partially sponsored the ongoing education of 1 female Sri Lankan refugee student in India currently attending medical college. All of this was made possible by OfERR, one of our dedicated partner organizations in India. As future doctors, teachers, engineers, and more, these young people are the future, and Visions is proud to have played a role in helping to empower them.

In Sri Lanka Visions also arranged through local partner organizations for 3 highly waraffected youth to partake in an intensive 6-month English training course in Jaffna. These
3 students (2 female and 1 male) were selected based off need and their individual career
goals. The course was started several weeks ago and will conclude in March 2012. The
support Visions provided will cover tuition fees, meals (for 2 students), bicycles (for 2
students), and 6 months of accommodation (for 1 student).

Launch of Tutoring/Mentoring Program for War-Displaced Children in Kilinochchi, Sri Lanka

In an ongoing effort to serve the needs of war-displaced youth recently resettled in Northern Sri Lanka, Visions has formed a partnership with the STITCH Movement, a group of highly motivated young professionals and students whose mission is to educate, advocate, empower & network for social change through youth volunteerism and activism in Sri Lanka. As our first joint effort, we have developed a youth mentoring and tutoring program for O/L students at an overcrowded school in Kilinochchi. A team of STITCH volunteers will make weekend trips to Kilinochchi for a period of 3 months to work with small groups of these O/L youth to do tutoring, engage the youth in a number of social and cultural activities (ie: sports, art, games, dance, etc.), provide a nutritious snack, help lay the foundation for peer tutoring, and otherwise observe and records the needs of the children and possible ideas to assist them moving forward. We are encouraged by this new partnership and look forward to hearing how this project has positively impacted the lives of these vulnerable young people!

(SRI LANKA: Colombo, Batticaloa, & Kandy):

Saturday, August 4th - Thursday, August 23rd

*This trip will feature one 7-day youth leadership training in Batticaloa and one 6day youth leadership training in Colombo. Volunteers are encouraged to participate in both trainings, but also have the option of participating in either training of their choice

To-date we have had 5 Visions volunteers give their time in Sri Lanka, the most recent of whom spent several weeks teaching computers at St. John's College in Jaffna and helping to push along some of our efforts there. We are always happy to take on volunteers and will work with you to develop a meaningful experience.
