As we reported in our last e-newsletter, thanks to the generous support of a private donor, Visions has partnered with St. John's College in Jaffna, Sri Lanka in developing and fully equipping a music room and computer lab in memory of the late Dr. Rex T. Arulananthan. In keeping with St. John's objectives, these efforts, focused on providing supplementary educational opportunities, will help enable the school to holistically nurture the body, mind, and spirit of these young people in order to empower them in discovering their talents, skills, and abilities. In response to the final phase of the war in Sri Lanka and the subsequent displacement of hundreds of thousands of people, St. John's provided free admission to 545 internally displaced (IDP) students in 2009, among which 222 were given free hostel accommodations. These new facilities will benefit these students and all others. Both rooms were opened to the students in January 2012 and have since begun offering regular programs. Projects Update from Sri Lanka & India



At the end of 2011, Visions provided assistance to the Women's Education and Research Centre (WERC) in Sri Lanka in support of a **women's trishaw drivers empowerment project**. WERC, which had already provided training to a group of marginalized women, simply needed the actual vehicles to hand over to the women. The trishaws were handed over to these deserving women on March 8th in Jaffna in commemoration of International Women's Day. These women are not only empowered to now provide for themselves and their families, they are also breaking down gender stereotypes and norms about the role of women in society and challenging the male-dominated order of this profession. It also has the potential to enhance the mobility and sense of security of women passengers, particularly those that travel alone.

In a continuation of our commitment to the tribal boarding school currently under construction in Dindigul, Tamil Nadu, India, Visions provided support in the amount of \$4,091 to SAWED Trust to purchase **10 classroom blackboards**. As progress continues steadily on the development of the new facility, SAWED is now starting to turn its attention to developing and equipping the actual classrooms. The school, which will serve tribal and dalit children, is set to open later this year.

Working in partnership with the STITCH Movement, after-school programs for Ordinary Level (O/L) students in Kilinochchi were conducted over a period of 6 weeks in November and December 2011. Instruction in basic subjects such as Tamil, English, math, and science have helped war-displaced students to catch up and put their education back on track. Evening classes were held within the Barathy Vidyalayam school premises for 6 consecutive weeks (2 hours/day, 3 times/week from Friday-Sunday), for 84 students sitting for their O/L examinations. STITCH volunteers and local staff were able to offer both classes/tutoring, as well as a midday meal for the students.



Past Events

For just 24 hours, Visions became the featured cause on Philanthroper.com, a website dedicated to bringing awareness to valuable causes and sharing with like-minded individuals the impact just \$1 can have on supporting communities in need. For \$1, a child at a Visions after-school tuition center can receive tutoring for a week. That covers

everything: the costs of the teacher, the teacher's housing and transportation, educational supplies and occasionally even a snack. This online campaign on March 6th resulted in raising \$718 from over 220 unique donors! If you feel so inclined, donations can still be made HERE.

The Toronto Chapter of Visions hosted a 4-on-4 basketball tournament on Saturday, February 18th, raising more than \$500. Ten teams participated in the event, and many more came to show their support, all of which created a friendly and exciting atmosphere. Thanks to all who attended and supported this event!

Finally, Visions information sessions were held in Davis, California and Ottawa, Canada to present summer volunteer opportunities in Sri Lanka and India to interested applicants. Our Chapter Coordinators Venita & Ganeya have been working diligently to get the word out.
