Check out our latest Visions short film about the learning center we built in partnership with Hindu Ladies College in Colombo, Sri Lanka to promote academic excellence, leadership, and personal development amongst deserving youth!

In 2010, construction on the five-story Kalagam Visions Learning Centre (KVLC) at the Saiva Mangaiyar Kalagam girls school in Colombo, Sri Lanka was completed, benefiting over 2,200 girls, including several hundred internally displaced children and orphans from Northeast Sri Lanka. This new facility includes a multimedia room, computer lab, activity rooms, additional classrooms, lecture halls, and student offices, as well as a sports court on the rooftop. In the long-term, this center will also provide trainings for teachers from other parts of Sri Lanka, as well as for local youth and community members.

Bridging the Education Gap for War-Affected Students in Sri Lanka



In partnership with the Church of the American Ceylon Mission (CACM), Visions is working to provide accelerated learning programs for war-affected youth in Sri Lanka to help them catch up in core subjects. With disruptions to their education and overall life during recurring bouts of conflict over the years, many bright and deserving youth have fallen behind in school. The goal of this training program is to provide enhanced and intensive educational support for students from rural communities to prepare for their O/L exams in December. These students' schools are poorly staffed, and as a result their education has been extremely uneven. The first Visions-sponsored accelerated training was held for two weeks in April 2012 for the benefit of 28 youth from selected communities where CACM is working in partnership with Visions in the Batticaloa District.

The students were split into three groups, receiving instruction in different subjects throughout the day from 8:00am-4:00pm, ensuring that students were taught in small groups and received more individual attention. The five core subjects included Tamil, English, Math, Science, and Social Science. Following classes, the students enjoyed sports time until 5.30 p.m. and then computer classes from 6:00-8:00pm. Most of the students had no knowledge about computers and had never before used one. During these two weeks they were given a basic introduction to computers and learned how to type and save files.

At the conclusion of the program there were an open evaluation session where students expressed their ideas and opinions. All students stated emphatically that these sessions were extremely helpful and that they were looking forward to the next session scheduled for August.
