Four Trainings in India & Sri Lanka Mark a Decade of Visions Leadership Trips!

This summer officially marked a decade of Visions leadership & life skills trainings in South Asia! Thanks to the commitment of our local partner organizations along with a number of repeat & new volunteers, we were able to conduct four (4) trainings this year -- two in India and two in Sri Lanka. Visions has now successfully held 28 leadership & life skills trainings since our inception.

The first two trainings this year were held at the ALC School Project training facility in Thirukoilur, India hosted by the Arcot Lutheran Church. A team of 8 international volunteers from West Virginia, New York, and California, led by Greg Buie, were joined by several local volunteers in conducting a 5-day intensive training for 50 ALC students in June. A second training in July, led by Meera Pathmarajah, was held for 40 Sri Lankan refugee youth, who were interviewed and individually selected for the program by staff at the Organization for Felam Refugees Rehabilitation (OfFRR)

Following a 5-year hiatus since our last group volunteer training program in Sri Lanka, Visions returned to Sri Lanka this summer and conducted two leadership trainings. Meg Whittenberger (pictured above), led a team of 7 international volunteers in a 6-day training at the Church of the American Ceylon Mission's (CACM) training facility in Batticaloa for 50 war-affected youth. The training was followed by a two-week accelerated learning program to help students bridge the gap of their formal education on account of displacement and war. Many of these same students had already attended a two-week accelerated learning program in the spring, further maximizing the impact on their lives and overall education. Finally, a training for 40 girls at the Kalagam Visions Learning Centre (KVLC) in Colombo was conducted later in August. All students expressed gratitude for the opportunity and had an enjoyable time learning, being creative, interacting with volunteers (both local and foreign), and developing a range of leadership skills.

We at Visions wish to thank all the international volunteers (see list of 20 total volunteers this year!) and local volunteers/translators for their time and commitment. Also, a big thank you is in order for our outstanding local partners who continue to support and facilitate these vital efforts, including the Arcot Lutheran Church (ALC), SAWED Trust, and OfERR in India; and the Church of the American Ceylon Mission (CACM) & Saiva Mangaiyar Kalagam in Sri Lanka. We are looking forward to next year already!!

Kilinochchi Kids Get Opportunity to Participate in Annual Games Competition

In June, Visions sponsored war-displaced children in Kilinochchi, Sri Lanka to attend and participate in an annual sports & games competition. Visions provided a grant of \$700 to support the service work of the Kilinochchi Kalvi Valarchchi Arakaddali (Kilinochchi Education Development Trust) to enable around 20 selected youth at Kanagapuram Maha Vidylayam in Kilinochchi to participate in this competition. With few opportunities to engage in fun activities like this in recent years, the competition was a rare, uplifting experience for the students.
