Honoring Deserving Medical Students in Chennai with Scholarships



N.S.S.T. Founder, Mathioli Saraswathy, who is the daughter of Jayalakshmi Ramachandran, enriched the ceremony with her presence.

A small ceremony was held on January 20th, 2013 for the two newest recipients of the Jayalakshmi Ramachandran Scholarship Program, a collaboration between Visions and the Nandalala Seva Samithi Trust in India. Mr. A. Kavin Kumar and Mr. S. Raguraman are both second year medical students pursuing an MBBS at Stanley Medical College in Chennai. Each of these young men earned very high marks on their secondary school exit exams and come from difficult financial backgrounds. The scholarship funds they received cover their tuition costs for the coming year. The JR Scholarship Program was established last year with the creation of an endowment fund, with the annual interest accumulated supporting disadvantaged students who have demonstrated high academic excellence and lack other options for support. The preference is to support those studying medicine, and all successful applicants make a commitment to repay part of their scholarship within 5 years either by service or monetarily, enabling many more future applicants to take advantage of this same opportunity.

In a new initiative, Visions is now in the midst of running its second accredited trip in India. As part of a partnership between Visions, Carnegie Mellon University, and Amizade Global Service Learning, a team of 10 students and 2 faculty from CMU are participating in a 3-month "Social Change Semester" coordinated locally by Visions. The group's goal is to learn how to change the world by partnering with those who are already making a difference. The group first spent 3 weeks in Qatar at CMU's Qatar campus where they volunteered with South Asian migrant communities before embarking on their journey in India. For the first month in India, the group is living at Mahatma Gandhi's ashram in Wardha, Maharashtra. While here, the group is working with a rural development organization, the Kamalnayan Jamnalal Bajaj Foundation, to carry forward Gandhi's legacy of service and empowerment. The Bajaj Foundation is actively engaged in water management, sustainable agriculture, education, and other community development projects. The group has so far conducted site visits over several days, engaged with local staff and community members in understanding the issues that affect their lives, and developing a strategy for how to support their efforts.

From Sevagram, the group will travel south to Chennai to volunteer locally with Visions' partners and conduct a 5-day youth leadership training. An update on Part II of this program will be shared in our next e-newsletter. Throughout their time in India, the group hopes to learn alongside their local counterparts how to mobilize social innovation in pursuit of social justice. For Visions, this represents a major step in further developing our accredited volunteer programs and enabling a larger pool of socially minded individuals to have the opportunity to learn and serve abroad. Volunteer Opportunity: Local Partner Assistance in Batticaloa

For the past several years, Visions has been partnering in Sri Lanka with the Church of the American Ceylon Mission (CACM) in developing and implementing educational programs for the benefit of disadvantaged youth in the Eastern and Northern Provinces. As our programs have grown and our reach expanded, so has the need for administrative responsibilities, including data collection, monitoring & evaluation, reporting & communications, and more.

These are all integral components of responsible development work, and our local partner is in need of assistance. Visions has agreed to fund a local staff person this year under CACM to take on these responsibilities, but we are actively seeking volunteers who are willing to go to Batticaloa and spend time with CACM in developing systems. training program staff, and generally



serving as a Visions ambassador. There is no specific timeframe, although the sooner the better (ideally sometime this spring). We will help to make any necessary logistical arrangements for you during your stay and will work with you in advance to prep you and hash out a plan.
